






Meeting Attendance





DEADLINE FOR INCLUSION IN PRINT MATERIALS - All applications must be received by Friday, December 30, 2022.

TERMS OF PAYMENT - Full payment must accompany the application for corporate exhibit space. No application will be accepted without remittance of full payment. Please note that if full payment is not received with the application you will not be guaranteed an exhibit booth. Payment receipt date will be used as the application submission date. Accepted forms of payment are MasterCard or Visa. Payments of \$5,000 or more must be made by check or EFT. TAX ID #: 36-3634626.

CONTRACT FOR SPACE - Exhibitors agree to accept and comply with the policies, rules and regulations contained in this Exhibitor Prospectus and on the Forum's website and all policies, rules and regulations adopted after publication of the Prospectus. The acceptance of an application by the AVF and the deposit for rental charges constitute a contract. The AVF reserves the right to not accept applications from exhibitors it deems inconsistent with the mission of the AVF or its Annual Meeting.

REFUNDS FOR CANCELLATION - Cancellations must be forwarded in writing by Friday, December 30, 2022. You will be refunded 50% of your exhibit booth fee, less \$1,500 administrative fee, only if the space can be resold. AVF will make every effort to resell exhibit space. However, if your space cannot be resold you will not receive any of your booth fee. There will be no refunds for cancellations received after midnight on Friday, December 30, 2022. However, if circumstances beyond our control, including, but not limited to: COVID-19, acts of God, governmental authority, declared war in the United States, terrorist attacks in San Antonio, curtailment of transportation either in San Antonio or in the countries/states of origin of the attendees that prevents the conference from taking place, or other circumstances beyond our reasonable control which would make it illegal or impossible for the AVF or The La Cantera Resort to hold the Conference, a full refund will be issued.

BADGE POLICY - All participants affiliated with exhibits must be registered. Badges are required to enter the exhibit space.
