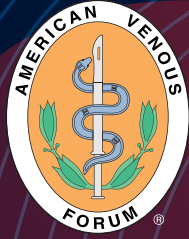

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This program is designed for residents, fellows, APPs, and early career physicians in the fields of vascular surgery, interventional radiology, interventional cardiology, vascular medicine, general surgery, and associated programs.

While the agenda is still being developed, the course will cover topics important to your organization, such as:

- Anatomy and pathophysiology of venous disorders and noninvasive diagnostics
- The evaluation and treatment of patients with chronic venous insufficiency - both superficial & deep
- Live ultrasound and sclerotherapy demonstrations
- Interactive case presentations
- The business of venous disease

COURSE DESCRIPTION

LEAD FACULTY



Steven Elias, MD, FACS, FABVLM is director of the Center for Vein Disease at Englewood Hospital. He is board certified in venous and lymphatic medicine and in general surgery and completed a fellowship in vascular surgery at Englewood Hospital. Educating new and current practitioners is the cornerstone of Dr. Elias's commitment to modern vein care and its impact on patient outcomes. He is the founder of the AVF Fellows Course and the medical editor of the AVF's VEIN Specialist newsletter. Dr. Elias's clinical interests include all aspects of minimally invasive vein care; he is also committed to procedure development and teaching. He has lectured, written, and taught about national and international vein disease. He has been the principal investigator/investigator on numerous clinical trials and performed the first ClariVein procedure on a human.



Robert Attaran, MD, FACC, FSCAI is Associate Professor of Medicine and the Director of the Endovascular Fellowship Training Program at Yale University. Dr. Attaran chairs the American Venous Forum's Early Career Committee and is a member of the AVF's Newsletter Committee. He is a board member of the American Board of Venous and Lymphatic Medicine and serves on a venous and lymphatic working group. He is the Chair of the Chronic Disease Guidelines Committee and Working Group of the Society for Cardiac Angiography and Intervention.

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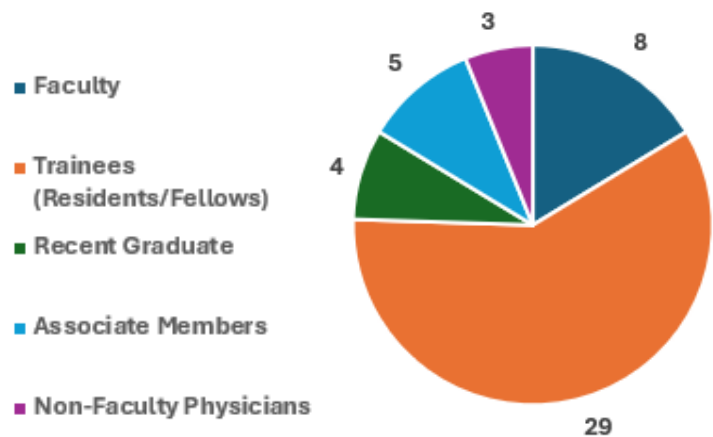

TRAVEL INFORMATION

The two most convenient airports are Ohare International Airport and Midway A, approximately 25 miles away.

Chicago O'Hare International Airport (ORD) is 18 miles from Radisson Blu Aqua Hotel, Chicago (45-minute ride). Taxi service (approx. \$40) departs at each terminal from the lower-level curb front (outside of Baggage Claim). Rideshare services such as Uber and Lyft are also available (approx. \$35) and depart from the Terminal 2 upper level (by color code) between doors 2A and 2D.

CTA Blue Line trains run 24 hours a day, seven days a week from O'Hare Airport to downtown Chicago. The normal travel time on the Blue Line from O'Hare to downtown, is 40 minutes.

Rideshare services such as Uber and Lyft are also available (approx. \$35) and depart from the from the lower-level Baggage Claim area, Door 4.

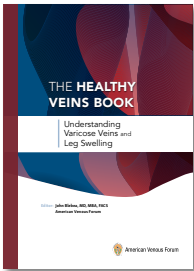
