Deliver a Strong Program - We have increased the abstract submission window by one month to provide additional time for researchers. We are actively pursuing greater outreach, both within and outside of the United States, to increase awareness of this great avenue to present original research.

Increase our Reach - While other meetings are returning to just in-person attendance, we will continue to offer a virtual option to maximize worldwide participation. The poster presentation session will also feature a hybrid format to enhance exposure for young researchers who may not be able to travel.

Provide a Great Experience - We have increased the time allotted to discussion so audiences can get a better understanding of the subjects covered in the presentations. We also added a dedicated program for Advanced Practice Providers, a foundational course on sclerotherapy, and a session dedicated to venous health care inequities.






Meeting Attendance

DEADLINE FOR INCLUSION IN PRINT MATERIALS - All applications must be received by Friday, December 29, 2023.

TERMS OF PAYMENT - Full payment must accompany the application for corporate exhibit space. No application will be accepted without remittance of full payment. Please note that if full payment is not received with the application you will not be guaranteed an exhibit booth. Payment receipt date will be used as the application submission date. Accepted forms of payment are MasterCard or Visa. Payments of \$5,000 or more must be made by check or EFT. TAX ID #: 36-3634626.

CONTRACT FOR SPACE - Exhibitors agree to accept and comply with the policies, rules and regulations contained in this Exhibitor Prospectus and on the Forum's website and all policies, rules and regulations adopted after publication of the Prospectus. The acceptance of an application by the AVF and the deposit for rental charges constitute a contract. The AVF reserves the right to not accept applications from exhibitors it deems inconsistent with the mission of the AVF or its Annual Meeting.

REFUNDS FOR CANCELLATION - Cancellations must be forwarded in writing by Friday, December 29, 2023. You will be refunded 50% of your exhibit booth fee, less \$1,500 administrative fee. only if the space can be resold. AVF will make every effort to resell exhibit space. However, if your space cannot be resold you will not receive any of your booth fee. There will be no refunds for cancellations received after midnight on Friday, December 29, 2023. However, if circumstances beyond our control, including, but not limited to: COVID-19, acts of God, governmental authority, declared war in the United States, terrorist attacks in Tampa, curtailment of transportation either in Tampa or in the countries/states of origin of the attendees that prevents the conference from taking place, or other circumstances beyond our reasonable control which would make it illegal or impossible for the AVF or the JW Marriott Tampa to hold the Conference, a full refund will be issued.
